Subject: Issues and Problems of Tractor manufacturers - reg

Sir,

I am to refer to the Home Ministry's Notification 4-3/2020- DM (I) A of dated 24.03.2020 and further Addendum on dated 25.03.2020, 27.03.2020 and 2.04.2020 and 3.04.2020, 10.04.2020 and 15.04.2020 regarding guidelines which inter alia stipulate following exemptions

- 1) Farming Operations by Farmers and Farm Workers in the field.
- Custom Hiring Centres(CHCs) related to Farm Machinery.
- Shops of Agricultural machinery and its spare Parts (Including Supply Chain) and repairs to remain Open
- 4) Intra and inter State movement of harvesting and sowing related machines like combine harvesters and other agriculture/horticulture implements
- 2. However, Tractor Manufacturers Associations has informed that the authorities concerned at State level are not allowing to operate the Tractors, Power tillers & its spare parts shops, dealer points and repair work shops because Ministry of Home Affairs in their Notifications under reference as above, has used the term "Shops for Agricultural Machinery and Its spare parts" (including supply Chain) and repair to remain open" without specifying the machineries.
- In the above Context, I am directed to clarify that the term "Agricultural
 machinery" also includes all type of tractors, Power tillers, trailers, combine harvesters and
 all other Agricultural machines used for Agriculture/farm operations.
- Therefore, it is requested to look into the matter with the authorities concerned at the States/Districts levels and issue the necessary clarification to them in the above matter.
